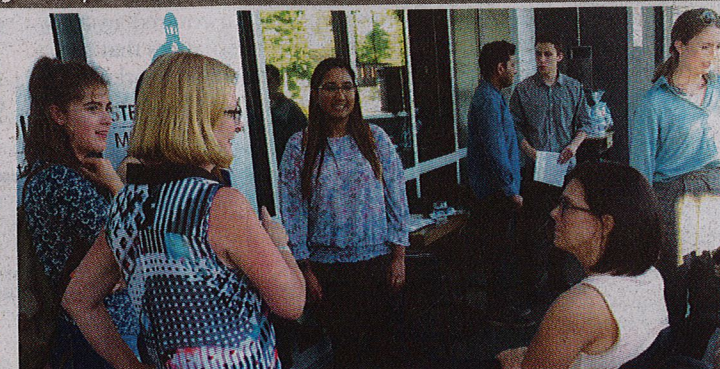

What is Happening in Your Legislature

The Legislature is back in session for the fall, and we are continuing our work in Victoria on behalf of Surrey families.

Ride-Hailing

Despite the current government's promise to deliver ride-hailing to British Columbians years ago, restrictive regulations continue to delay the arrival of ride-hailing services. The province needs both a strong taxi industry and ride-hailing services, and we will continue to advocate for a level playing field so that British Columbians have access to more transportation options throughout the province.

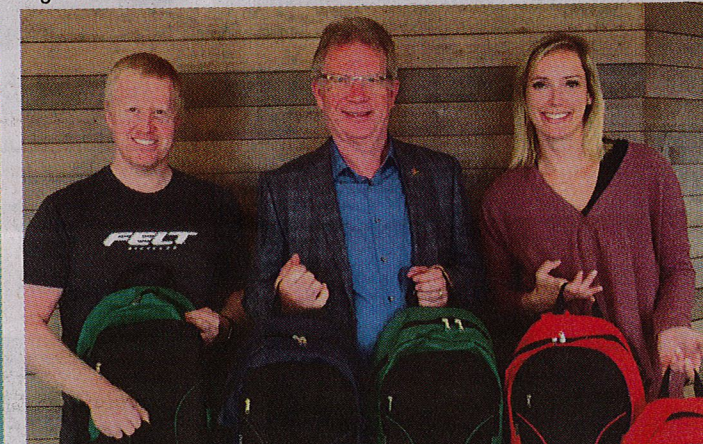
Investing in Surrey

Had the government not cancelled the Massey Replacement, the 10-lane bridge with dedicated transit lanes, would be 50 per cent complete today. The recent announcement that government will instead be looking to build an 8-lane tunnel will have a much greater impact on the Fraser River than a bridge and will require a lengthy environmental assessment. This is concerning for both the years of delay and the increased costs to taxpayers.

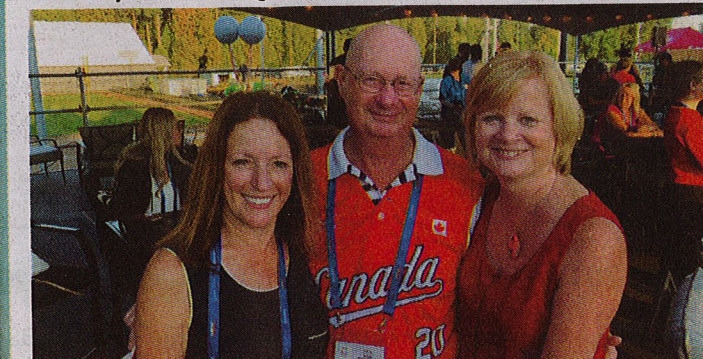

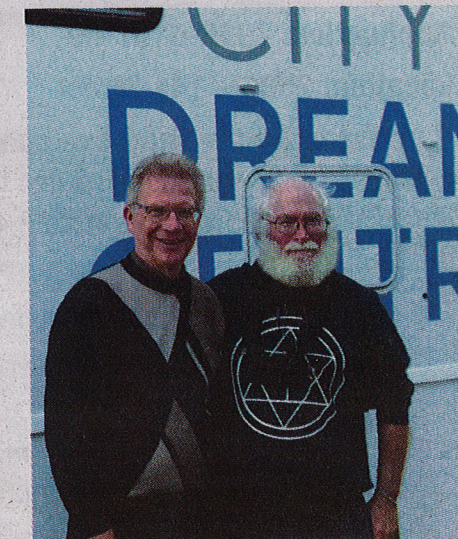
